VOYAGER IMAGE OF NEPTUNE

IN THE SUMMER OF 1989, NASA'S VOYAGER 2 BECAME THE FIRST SPACECRAFT TO OBSERVE THE PLANET NEPTUNE, ITS FINAL PLANETARY TARGET. PASSING ABOUT 4,950 KILOMETERS (3,000 MILES) ABOVE NEPTUNE'S NORTH POLE, VOYAGER 2 MADE ITS CLOSEST APPROACH TO ANY PLANET 12 YEARS AFTER LEAVING EARTH IN 1977.
